Madoz uses the Hasselbald, a medium format camera made in Sweden. Chema Madoz: Objetos (1990 to 1999) was most likely entirely made using this version of the camera. In addition to this, he previously used Mamiya's camera. Madoz's first solo exposition took place in 1983 at Madrid's Royal Photographic Society.
